

# Stars & Stripes Down on the Farm Preschool Camp 2017 Camp Spotlight



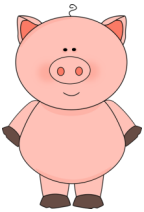

*Your little farmer will learn about farm animals and what vegetables are grown on farms during Down on the Farm Preschool Camp! They can look forward to a week full of fun, hands-on activities and games. Children will be able to plant their own seeds to take home, make real butter, and so much more! Each day campers will learn about a different farm animal, read a fun farm story, and complete creative art projects.*

**Monday: Cows** Welcome to Down on the Farm Preschool Camp, farmers! We will start off our exciting week by talking about cows. After reading *Click Clack Moo: Cows That Type*, we will work on a silly art project where we will decorate our own cow pictures using BINGO daubers. Instead of being white with black spots, our cows will be all sorts of fun colors and designs! We will also make our own cow out of a paper plate, and then make our own butter! We will get a chance to try our butter on crackers as a small yummy snack !



**Tuesday: Pigs** Today we will read *I Know a Wee Piggy*. Then we will get “messy” painting our own pigs with brown paint (pretending that it is mud). We will also explore dried corn in our sensory bin with animal counters and measuring cups. Campers will be able to practice their pouring and measuring skills. Campers will also make their very own “Feed the Pig”.

**Wednesday: Sheep** Get ready to learn about sheep! We will begin our day by reading *Down by the Barn* together. Next, get ready for some soft and fuzzy fun as we make our own sheep... out of cotton balls! We will also use BINGO daubers to decorate our own sheep pictures with fun colors. Campers will also get to spend some time doing dramatic play with farm animal masks, practicing taking turns and playing together appropriately.

**Thursday: Horses & Chickens** Another exciting day of farm fun will start with reading the story *Chicken Cluck*. We will make paper plate horses for our art project. Then we will explore dry oats in the sensory bin with cups and animal counters, using our imaginations. We will also play with animal movement command cards, doing activities like galloping like a horse and rolling like a pig.



**Friday: Vegetables** Get ready for a super fun day filled with vegetables and water fun! Today we will start by reading *Growing the Alphabet*. Campers will plant their very own seed to take home and watch it grow! Then, we will make our own corn art using our handprints and enjoy some time in the inflatable bounce house. Today is water day so come prepared by bringing your swimsuit, a towel and apply sunscreen! It's going to be a blast!
