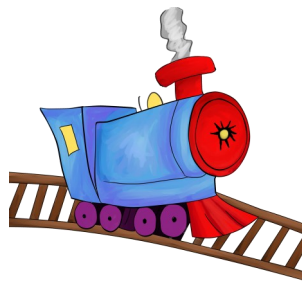


Stars & Stripes Planes, Trains & Automobiles Preschool Camp 2017 Camp Spotlight



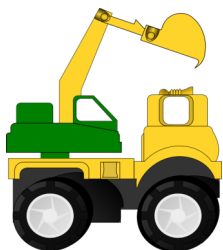

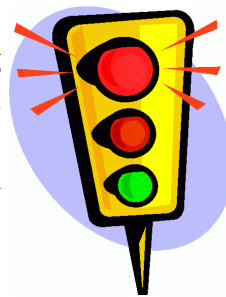

On Friday we will wrap up our week with a water day, so bring your bathing suit and towel for tons of fun!

Wednesday: Planes & Trains Welcome to Planes, Trains, and Automobiles Camp! We will kick off our camp with a day full of trains and airplanes. We will read *Down by the Station* and pretend to be in the vehicles that are in the story. Campers will build trains and make a craft train using the letters of our name as train cars. Campers will also love exploring play dough with transportation cutters and making their own paper airplanes to fly!



Thursday: Trucks Today our story will be *Tough Trucks*, since we are diving into our day themed with trucks! We will make our own ramps from a variety of materials. Next, we will make our very own truck puzzles and decorate them. Campers will get to build their own trucks (using felt pieces) using their imaginations!

Friday: Traffic Signals Get ready for our last exciting day of camp, packed with learning about traffic signals and having a blast with water day. First we will start with story time and read the book *Curious George Rides*. Then, we will have a craft for making our own stoplights and enjoy the inflatable bounce house. We will play Red Light, Green Light to learn the different signals and what you should do at each one. Today is water day so come prepared by bringing your swimsuit, a towel and apply sunscreen!
